Summary

With more than 30 years of experience in public health at national and international levels, Dr Asadi-Lari has served his country, Eastern Mediterranean Region and at international levels in serving public health, particularly health systems, non-communicable diseases and health diplomacy in different capacities.

Dr Asadi-Lari graduated from medical school in 1992, and served deprived areas of southern Iran as a medical doctor in a remote rural health centre for two years and then as a junior expert in the National PHC Expansion Centre, where he promoted gradually to senior staff manager within seven years. He pursued his PhD in Epidemiology in the University of Nottingham, UK, then as a post-doctoral fellowship in University of Warwick.

As a professor of epidemiology, he has trained and supervised more than 150 postgraduate students, led several national studies such as Urban HEART, contributed in many national and international research projects and published more than 180 scientific papers, majority of them in prestigious English peer-reviewed journals. Dr Asadi-Lari played an important role in the WHO, Executive Board (2013-15) and at various regional and global levels, built up a strong collaboration with the health sectors of more than 90 countries, and as a member of the Board at the Global Fund since 2015, he is responsible for coordinating regional and international activities to fight HIV/AIDS, Malaria and Tuberculosis.
